# AAF GUNNERS WEAR WINGS



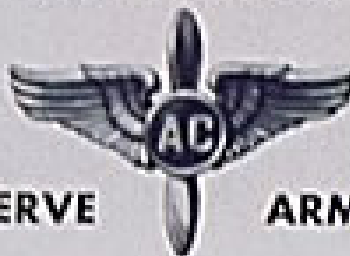

was assigned to the AAF Enlisting Board at Dallas, Texas. The young men are members of the Civil Air Patrol, sponsored by AAF, and the AAFRC represent their first plane ride.



◆ CALIFORNIA - Two 27-year-olds receive their blue-and-silver AAFRC wings at Los Angeles, California, from Enlisting Board member, AAF pilot who was assigned to the Southwest Pacific after having been out for six months. The knowledge of aviation, from AAFRC, has pleased these young men and given them the idea that they are called to serve their country as pilots. In that case, they will be trained for their job, as an enlisted man.

◆ INDIANA - These 27-year-olds who have just completed the Air Corps Enlisting Reserve at Indianapolis, Indiana, get their AAF wings from Flight Instructor Jackie Karpis, who is a former member of the unit and was an AAF pilot. Karpis was given their wings and after they receive flight instruction which will take them all out on air routes over a general area before, assignment, or job. Meanwhile, they may get their college training under the GI Bill.

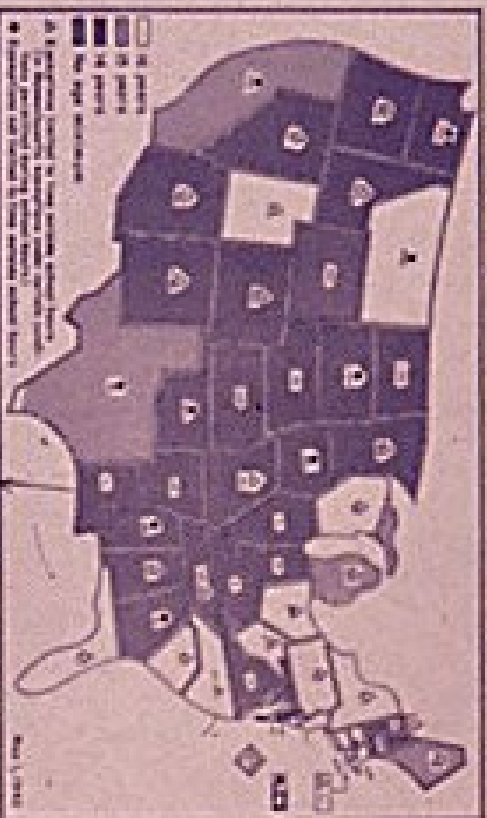


# GOOD CHILD-LABOR LEGISLATION PROMOTES THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF CHILDREN

A basic 16-year minimum age for employment in establishments producing goods for interstate commerce is provided by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, but only 47 States have a basic 16-year minimum by State law.

Legend: 16 years or more; 14 years; 12 years; No age restriction.

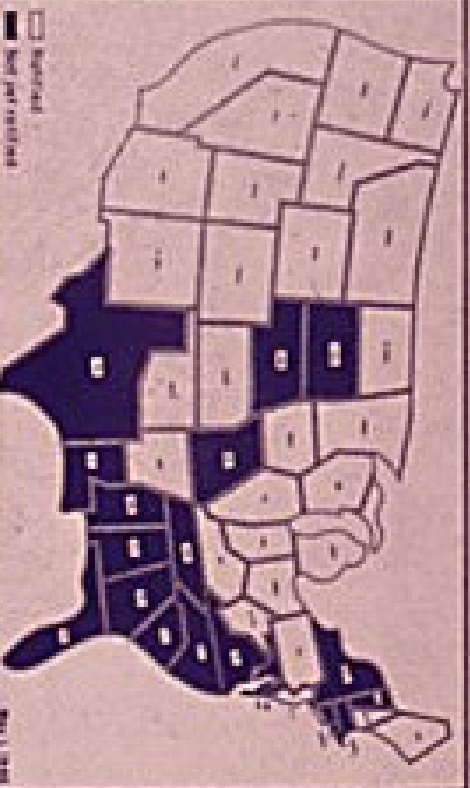

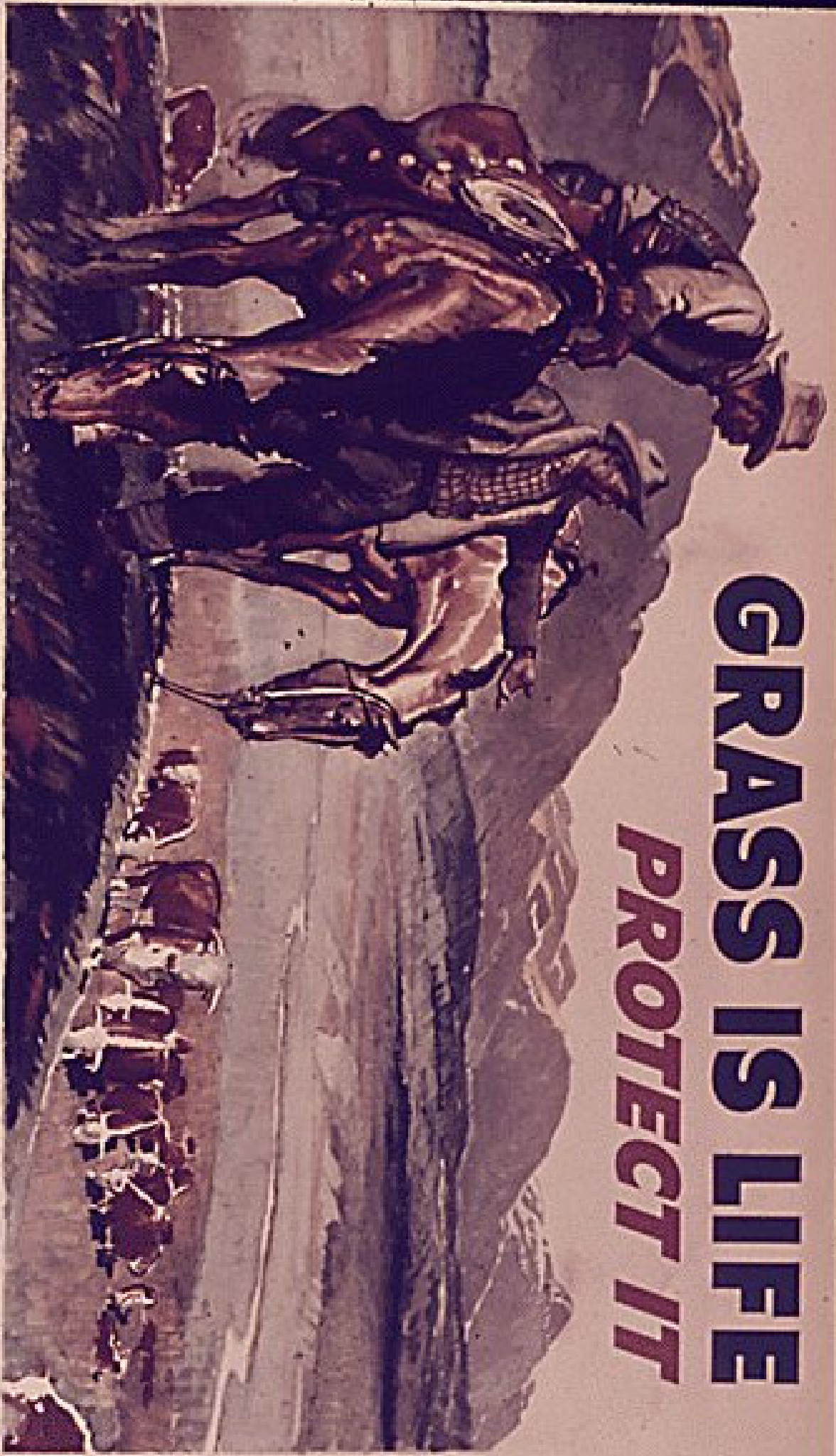

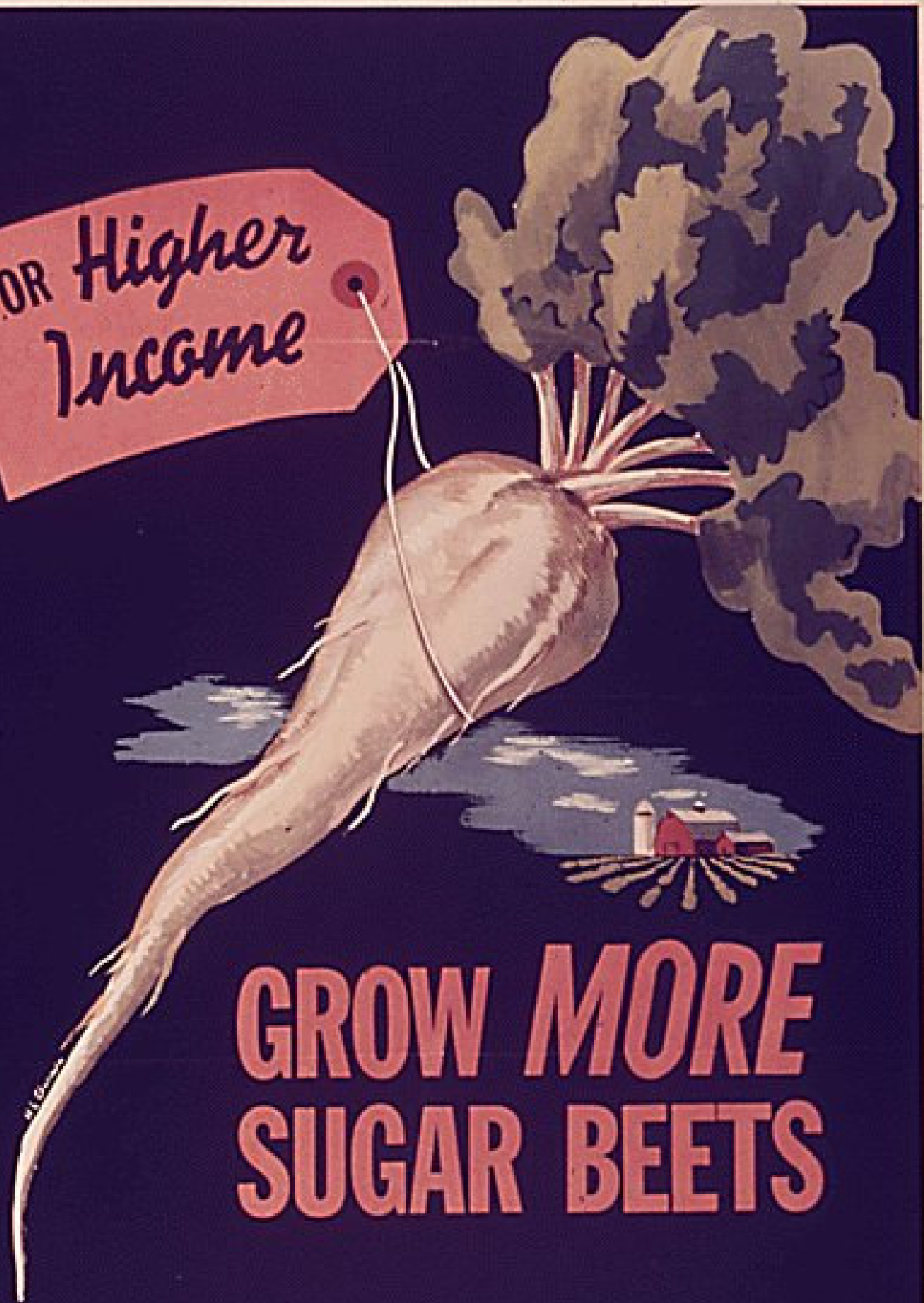
