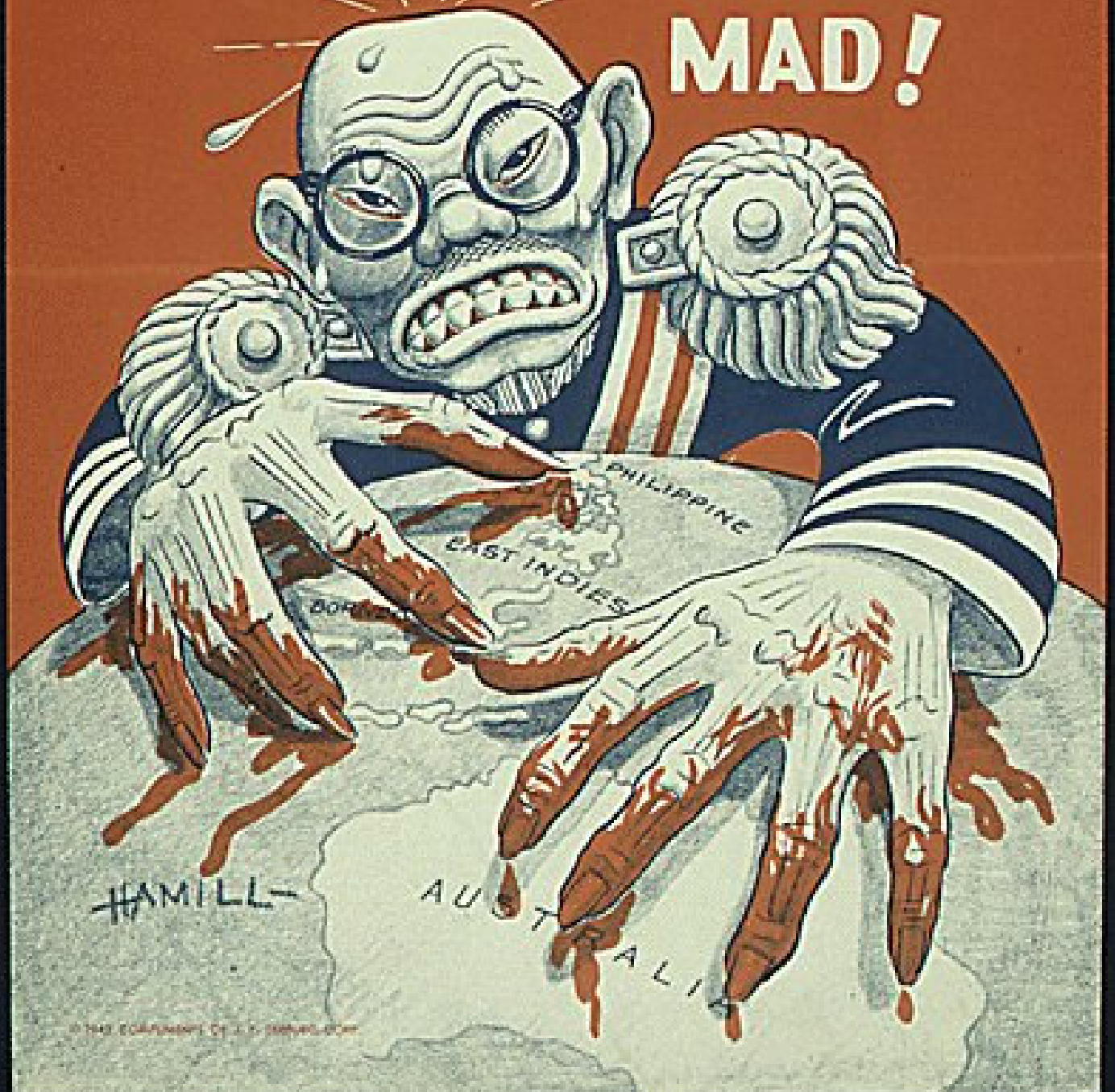

Civilian War Services.

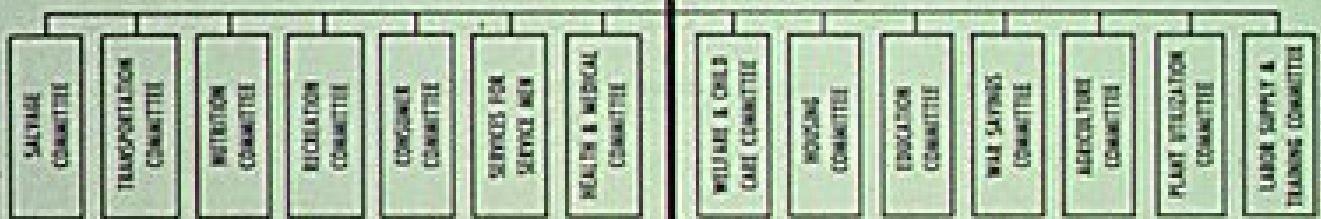
This chart shows the organization of the block plan for

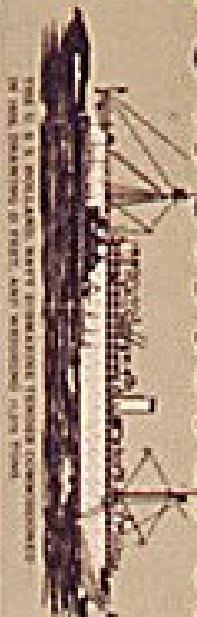

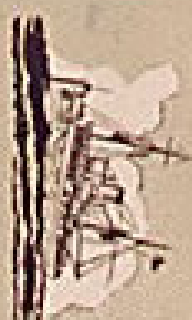

HOW TO PREVENT FOREST FIRES

MATCHES. Do not use matches to eat. Break it in two before you throw it away.

SMOKING. Smoke only while stopping in a safe place clear of all inflammable material.

TOBACCO. Do not use pipe stems and tips or cigarette butts as kind before discarding them away. Never throw them into brush, leaves, or needles.

MAKING CAMP. Before building a fire scrape away all inflammable material from a spot ten feet in diameter. Dig a hole in the center and in it build your campfire. Keep your fire small. Never build it against trees or logs or near brush.

BEARING CAMP. Never build camp until your fire is out—dead out. Always leave a clean camp.



HOW TO PUT OUT A CAMPFIRE. Use the rocks while making them with water. Turn small sticks and break both sides. Wet the ground around the fire. Do not use the last stick in dead.

BEEN BURNING. Never leave dead or fresh in windy weather or while there is the slightest danger that the fire will get away.

EXTINGUISH any small fire you see.

REPORT any fire you discover. Go to the nearest telephone and ask for the local Forest Ranger or Fire Warden.
