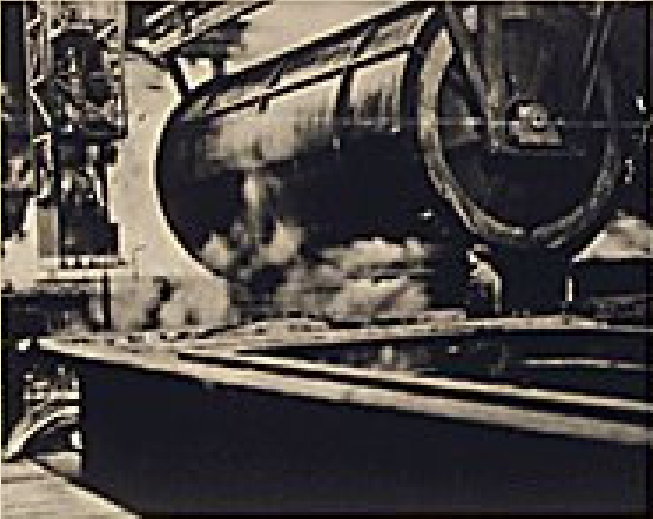
# TIN CANS GO TO WAR



The scrap collector prepares for his work, and gets down to it for collection.



About 150,000 tin cans fill a freight car. They are off to the melting plant.



It's "boiler" tin to come out "boiler" and then the cooling machine.



When the glass variety is the great quantity, before it's poured into molds.



Each of these "jugs" contains 100 pounds of glass, collapsed from about 400 tin cans. The job of "jugs" also allows workers through the heat. Remains of impurities float out.



Only about 1% of a tin can is this tin, a 1936. When the tin is removed the cans are crushed into being today, and poured on to the steel mill.

# TIRES MUST BE CONSERVED


That's no joke, soldier. The tire shortage, serious for more than a year, is now critical. It's real—so real that even the Army, accustomed to getting everything it needs, must learn to get along with fewer tires in 1944 than it had in 1943. It's an OFFICIAL fact that few, IF ANY, new tires will be available for Army trucks anywhere in the United States. Proper care of tires must offset this reduction, and will, if you do your part. Otherwise, you will ride less and walk more!



# TO ALL WHO USE LIBRARIES

One of the first acts of the Japanese in the Philippines was to destroy an American library. The policy of the Nazis and the Fascists toward libraries, librarians, writers of books, and readers of books has long been familiar to us. The Japanese by their act of barbarism adopted the Nazi policy for themselves.

But they did more than that. They brought directly home to Americans the menace of this war to American civilization, American culture, and American books—as well as those who use American books, produce American books, and care for American books.
