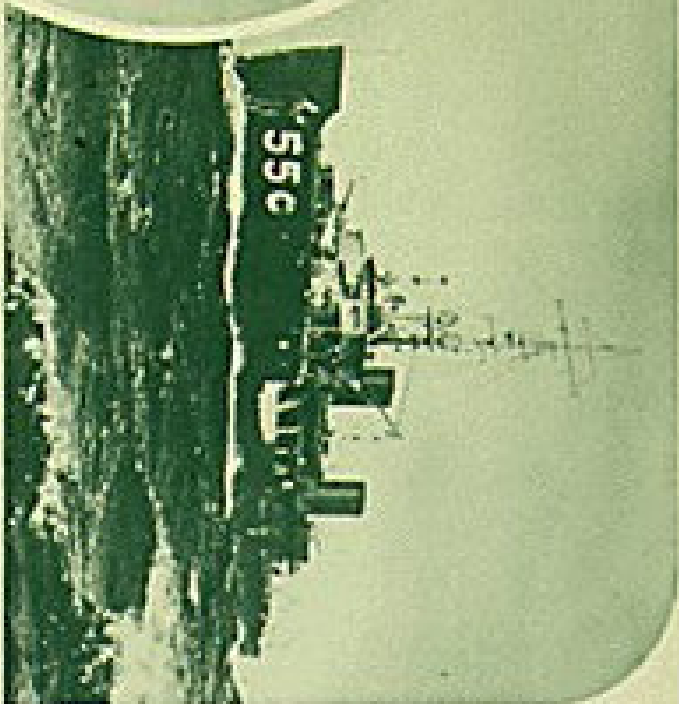

For 24 days they drifted . . . with only that rubber raft between them and eternity.

"About the fifth day lack of water bothered us seriously. We bled in the sun, watching showers approach, then fade away . . . In the blazing sun, surrounded by sharks and rolling waves, we held the first of what became a daily prayer service.

"Sometimes as I look back on those 24 days, rain and moss heavy seas and flat calm seas and nothing comes out but a feeling of hunger and thirst and sadness.

"By the 20th day there was no longer much talk. Mostly we lay in our cramped positions, not caring what happened. Then on the 23rd day we struck the beginnings of a hurricane.

Suddenly the boat tipped over. All we saved was one shoe. There we were, returned to the primal, stark naked and alone, fighting the howling storm. Afterwards the sun came out. Our bones stuck out of our inflated bodies which burned and peeled and burned again. We wanted to give up. But we shook heads and went on . . ."

They were saved.

They were saved by \$100 worth of war bonds. The price of a rubber raft. Money that you lent to your government.

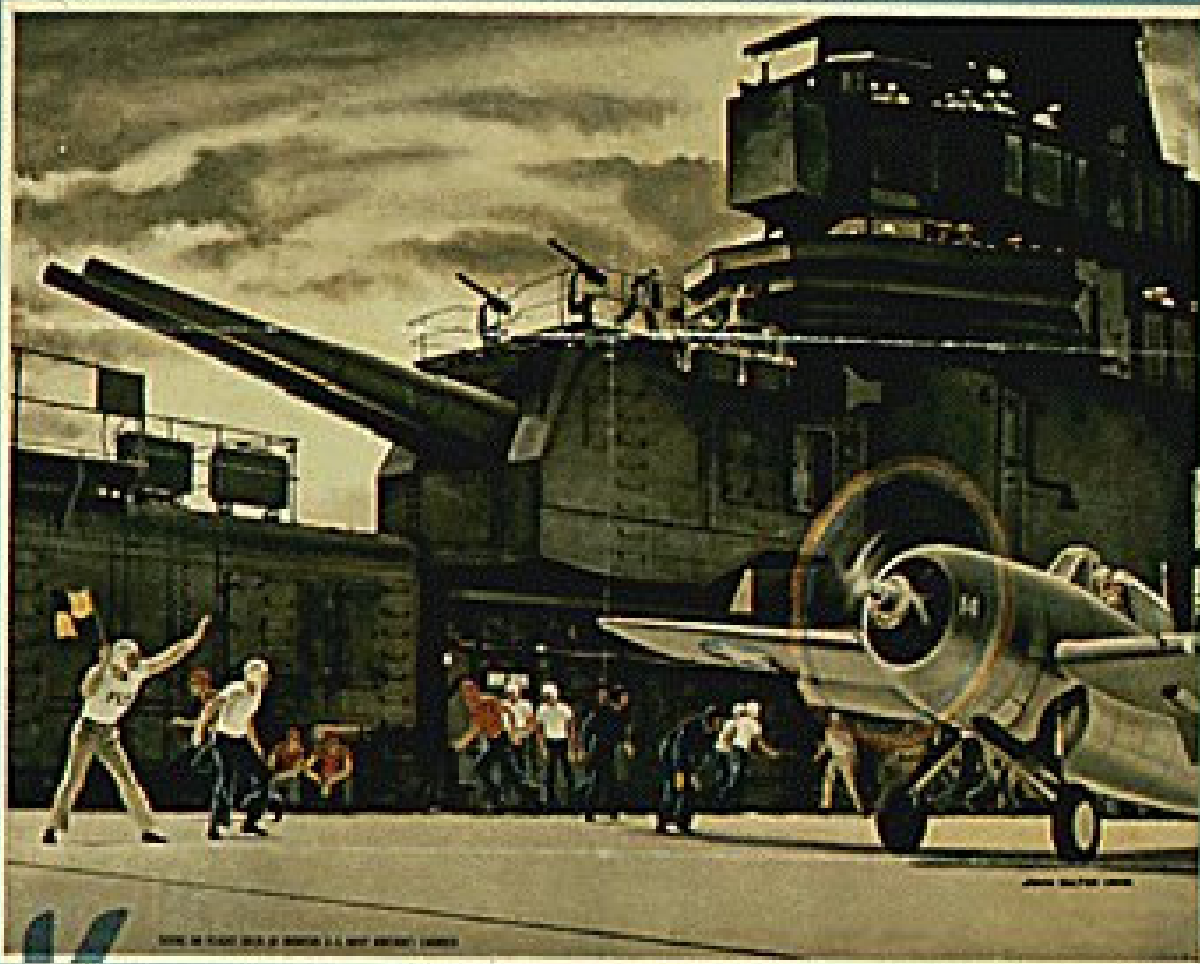
